#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF NOMINATION

1. A Club cannot have more than one member or associate member nominated onto the GBLCC
2. If a Club already has a member or associate member accepted on the GBLCC, then it can elect to either not nominate a person or nominate a person associated within the Club's Region.
3. The nominated person must understand and be willing to serve on the GBLCC for a minimum period of two (2) seasons.
4. The nominee understands that if elected to the GBL Competition Committee, the elected person is making decisions that are best for the GBL baseball competition and not for a particular Club or interest group.



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#### THE OBJECTIVES OF THE GBLCC

- To ensure that GBL competitions are conducted with the highest degree of integrity, fairness, transparency and common sense.
- To provide suitable competition pathways for all players to reach their playing goals
- To provide an enjoyable and fulfilling experience for all participants
- To maintain a safe playing environment for all participants.

#### MEMBERS' SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE

Members shall have diverse, complementary backgrounds and the Committee collectively should have the appropriate skills and experience to undertake its responsibilities.

These may include all or some of the following:

- a hands on involvement in juniors or seniors baseball competition
- have networks within the wider baseball community on matters that are important for the development of the sport
- experience in sports scheduling
- experience in baseball coaching, umpiring, scoring or in GBL Club administration
- a wide knowledge of The Rules of Baseball
- an understanding of how Clubs operate within the GBL
- an understanding of the issues relating to the connections between GBL Clubs and their Regions
