IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Baseball across Australia recently adopted a range of rules and practices to speed up the game. The concept behind this policy is to potentially provide participants with more participation opportunities that will result in more At Bats and more innings being played in the same time frame. A key part of this process identifies a need to encourage all Umpires to expand the strike zone. It is in this regard that we ask that you consider the Umpire's role in effecting this change and we ask that you support our officials in their efforts to improve the game.



Six pitch locations, all out of the strike zone. Six consecutive home runs for Miguel Cabrera. Sure he's exceptional. At this time the zone within which he could consistently drive the ball, was bigger than the strike zone.

Encourage hitters to be aggressive so they can explore their potential to develop into a better hitter in the long run.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Encouraging hitters to be aggressive on any pitch they think they can hit hard can give the hitter a foundation to refine themselves into a better hitter later in life. They either get better at driving balls pitched in a wider variety of locations or at the very least they figure out their strengths and weaknesses through trial and error. If the hitters are aggressive at the plate, they put the ball in play earlier in their at bat and more often. This makes the game move along and makes for a better spectacle for all. In addition, the defense get more opportunities to attempt to make plays.
