BY LAWS

Rules Applicable:

Official Rules of Baseball Baseball Queensland Tech Norms

Big League State Titles By-Laws (this document).

Tech Norms Rule 8.4. Team roster sizes: Minimum roster size of 14.

Big League State Titles By-Law: Minimum roster size does not apply to the Big League State Titles.

Tech Norms Rule 12.1.1. Age of players. Age of players. Specifies players must be U18 years of age.

Big League State Titles By-Law: Age eligibility as per GBL U18/U20 age eligibility requirements. Each Big League team may also name up to three (3) players up to 22 years of age as at 31 December in the year of the Tournament.

Tech Norms Rule 16.3. Coaches attired in the same uniform as players. Requires coaches to wear similar attire to the players.

Big League State Titles By-Law: Regions determine the uniform for their coaching staff.

Tech Norms 23.1 Regulation Game.

Big League State Titles By-Law: Regulation game will consist of five (5) complete innings or 45 minutes. Game length is 9 Innings or two hours. No new inning may be commenced with less than 10 minutes of play remaining. An inning started before 10 minutes shall be completed unless the home team is in the lead during their turn at bat. An inning starts immediately after the final out of the previous inning.

32.4.1 Player Participation - Defensive Outs. Requires 43 DO's for all rostered players for the two day tournament.

Big League State Titles By-Law: No mandatory play conditions exist.
